



RINGMER FOOD BANK

Ringmer Food Bank is operated by Ringmer Baptist Church and is open from 11am to 12pm every Monday at Ringmer Village Library. This service is

available to individuals and families referred by local welfare organisations for emergency aid. The Baptist Church is also happy to help anyone who has had a setback and needs help, even if they don't have an official referral letter. The Baptist Church are happy to accept donations for the Food Bank. These can be dropped in when the Food Bank is open on Mondays, or alternatively left in the dropbox outside the front of the library (please don't leave any jars or anything breakable in the dropbox). Donations can also be left on the doorstep at 11 Delves Close. There is a lot of demand for the food bank at the moment and all donations are gratefully received.

WARM SPACE AND ENERGY ADVICE AT RINGMER LIBRARY

Ringmer Library is part of the Warm Spaces network. This means you can drop in at any time during their opening hours (Tuesday, Thursday and Friday afternoons between 2 and 5pm and Wednesday and Saturday mornings between 10am and 12pm) to work, read, chat, meet friends or just hang out in the warm (see p15 for more information on the library).

Anyone concerned about their heating bills (and who isn't right now?) can head to the library on Tuesday 17 January between 2.30 and 4.30pm for a free session with an Ovesco energy champion. It's an opportunity to ask any questions about your heating system, whether that's a boiler or radiator issue, and to discuss ways to economise.

NEWS FROM RINGMER PARISH COUNCIL

Councillor David Duke says: "We would like to wish all Ringmer residents a very Happy New Year. Here is the latest news from the Parish Council."

Parking – Thanks to all residents who contacted us about parking after the December Newsletter. Parking on the grass verges in the village and extending the double yellow lines at the Harrisons Lane junction with Lewes Road were discussed at the recent Parish Council meeting. The council agreed to forward both matters to the next ESCC consultation in mid-January for consideration.

Budget 2023/24 - The council approved a budget at £157,094 for the next financial year. The precept figure would be agreed when the council receives the tax base information from Lewes District Council.



King Charles III's Coronation, 6 May 2023 - A meeting on 10 January 2023 at 11 am in the council offices will bring together local groups to discuss how best to celebrate the Coronation.

Groups include the Brownies, Ringmer Evergreen Club, Ringmer WI, the Village Hall and the Library along with the Primary and Secondary schools, councillors from LDC, ESCC and our MP. The council will also consult with

the Lord of the Manor regarding Coronation mugs for the children.

Skatepark - Following the approval of the Croudace planning application, the council discussed the fact that Croudace had offered to include a skatepark as part of the community assets in their application. As no formal approach has been made, we agreed to move ahead with the Fingerpost Field site. The next step is the archaeological survey on the site.

Christmas Tree - Cllr Crisp was thanked for his kind donation of the Christmas Tree and lights for the Village Green. It was suggested that mulled wine, mince pies and singing carols celebrate the switching on of the lights next year.

May 2023 Elections - The local elections in May 2023 will see the current Parish Council replaced by a newly elected group of residents. Johnny Denis is unable to stand for re-election due to his other commitments and has offered to speak to any resident considering putting themselves forward as candidates. UPDATE FROM CLLRS EMILY O'BRIEN AND JOHNNY DENIS



RESCUE FOR RINGMER POOL?

Cllr Johnny Denis says: "Lewes District Council is ready to step in to stop the County Council closing Ringmer Pool for Good. The District Council has surveyed the buildings and equipment and has identified a number of costs needed to bring it back into use and is talking with East Sussex to agree terms for a lease to re-open the pool. While agreement is

not yet finalised, this is a huge boost to the community campaign set up to keep the pool open. I am thrilled that the District has been able to offer this level of support to bring the pool back from the brink. It's seen as a hugely important asset for us all. So many members of the community worked hard to build it and run it in the first place and the community has again fought long and hard to save it from closure by the County Council. They will be delighted they have the confirmed support of the District Council!"

RESPECT OUR ROADS CAMPAIGN

Cllr Emily O'Brien says: "Following November's protest on the Green, we're continuing to fight to keep HGVs away from villages and unsuitable roads - a problem throughout our ward, including Ringmer. My motion to the last District Council meeting successfully introduced new requirements for construction traffic from building sites and also supported a campaign for commercial sat navs in HGVs. Despite Conservative members of LDC arguing against writing to ESCC to ask them to come up with a better road plan for HGVs because 'It's not a problem we can solve and it's out of our control!' the motion was passed."

PLANNING UPDATE

Emily says: "We were delighted that the committee voted unanimously to reject the BokLok proposal in December. For the first time, the unacceptable discharge from the sewage works was given as a reason for refusal following months of campaigning. The Government's U-turn on the controversial housing target system just the day before was an important reason for this. But we wonder whether this all too little too late. We've written to Maria Caulfield asking for her assurance that the U-turn will mean that three major earlier appeal decisions will be overturned or compensation paid for the damage already done. We will update on this when we can."


