



On 16 June 2023, Ringmer Library will celebrate its fifth birthday as a community run library. Over those five years, the library has:

- Doubled its space.
- Dropped fines for late returns.
- · Changed its book stock twice
- Made more than 500 home deliveries



- Spent more on new books than when it was run by ESCC.
- Processed ten tons of donated books.
- Increased opening hours by 25%.
- Started to lend jigsaws and games.

In the past year alone, the library has:

- Opened for 50 extra hours as part of the Warm Space scheme.
- Introduced free tea and coffee making facilities.
- Hosted Hearing Aid maintenance sessions.

On Friday 16 June, the library will open between 3 and 5pm with giveaway books for children and tea and biscuits for all. Celebrations will carry on in the morning of 17 June between 10 and 12pm. Why not drop by?

NEWS FROM RINGMER PARISH COUNCIL



PARISH COUNCIL ELECTIONS

As only nine nominations were received for the 13 seats on the Parish Council, those nine were elected unopposed to serve for the next four years. Two new Councillors, Linda Grange and Nic Challoner, were nominated. At the first meeting of the new council in May, Cllr Gordon Sims was re-elected Chair and Cllr Sarah Phillips Vice-Chair. There will be an opportunity for residents to meet members of the new council on Thursday

15 June at 6.30pm in the Parish Rooms. Parish Council meetings are open to residents and take place on the second Tuesday of the month at 7.30pm in the Parish Rooms. Residents are able to make a three minute address at the start of the meeting on any matter of concern.

We have four vacancies for any residents who may be interested in becoming a Parish Councillor. Younger residents of the village are particularly underrepresented on the council. Please contact the Clerk for more information.

IMPROVING THE NATURAL ENVIRONMENT IN RINGMER

An informal group was set up to promote the Parish's involvement with the 'Save our Wild Isles' campaign. The council will continue to support the work of existing volunteer groups and will also encourage wider participation with small scale projects. Leaving areas to develop naturally, planting native wild species and doing less weeding will all support our pollinators. Using nesting boxes and creating small garden ponds will help other species and help compensate for the loss of areen spaces within the village boundary.

YOUNG PEOPLES' PLAY AREAS

A recent review of the play areas within the village was discussed. It was noted that facilities are not consistent across the parish with specific age ranges not being properly supported. It was agreed that the playground area on Fingerpost Field should be updated and that more 'social' seating designs should be used across the village for small groups rather than the current traditional benches. It is hoped that the Council's planning application for the Fingerpost Field skate park will be discussed at the June Planning Committee meeting. It was agreed to provide some social seating between the shopping precinct and Delves House.

SOUTHERN WATER

Some Councillors met with three representatives of Southern Water on Friday 12 May to discuss ongoing issues. Information about the role of different companies in dealing with excess surface water was received. It was also noted that some remedial work had been done on one of the sewers from the village to the Neaves Lane Water Treatment Plant.

WILDFLOWER RINGMER - THE BIG HELP OUT



As part of the Coronation celebrations. Monday 8 May was designated as national volunteering day. King Charles' love of our native wildflowers is well known so it seemed especially fitting to ask for volunteers to help us plant more than 100 wildflowers in the area we manage by the Village Green banks. We were pleased to have the help of a lovely group of enthusiastic volunteers who did an absolutely brilliant job in quite challenging waterlogged conditions. Thanks team!



Our recent survey shows that, among others that survived from planting last year, there are ox-eye daisies, evening primrose, ragged robin, fox and cubs, marjoram, selfheal, crosswort, common vetch and Devil's-bit scabious in the area.

"We've also introduced white campion, field scabious and purple loosestrife and, of course, many other species are growing there without our

intervention! Some species are in flower now but the main show will be later in the summer. The three beds dug in the well-house are now full of cornfield annual seedlings including cornflower and common Poppy, which will also produce a colourful show.

We will be watering frequently to help the new plants establish and continue to manage the grass to prevent it overwhelming the wildflowers. The Wildflower Areas are easily identified as they are left unmown by the contractor. The plants are delicate so please admire from the edge or tread very carefully. Thank you for your consideration.

NATIONAL AWARD FOR JOHN KAY



On 18 May Dr John Kay, Chairman of Ringmer History Study Group (RHSG), won the Outstanding Individual Contributor Award for 2023 from the British Association for Local History. This prestigious honour is given to a local historian who has made a significant voluntary contribution in the subject in their locality. John's award recognises the major contribution he has made in both Ringmer and Lewes to the study of local history. He was a co-founder of

RHSG in 1981 and has been its chairman for 42 years. In 2009, he co-founded the Lewes History Group (LHG).

With his unstinting enthusiasm and wide local knowledge, past and present, John was especially singled out for his four decades of producing monthly newsletters for first RHSG (number 371 has just been published for May), then LHG too. John has dealt with researchers' enquiries from around the world for both groups while carrying out many other voluntary roles in the community including Chairmanship of Ringmer Parish Council from 2010 to 2016.

Prior to retiring, John was a Reader in Biochemistry at the University of Sussex, Associate Dean of the Brighton and Sussex Medical School, and previously the Director of the Centre for Medical Research. He is also a published author in both history and biomedical journals. To people in Ringmer John has been Mr History for more than 40 years. His research has been immaculate and immense, his developed knowledge has become encyclopaedic and his energy seems boundless. Congratulations to John on being presented with this major award.


